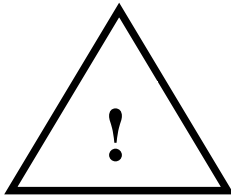

1. Do you, in your operations as recognizing NCB, request sample(s) while processing the "recognition" of CBTCs?

Yes/ No.

If yes, why?

Our "yes" reply is only valid for the few cases in which national or group differences have not been checked by Body A. In particular some of the Danish national deviations to IEC 60884-1:2002 (DS/IEC 60884-1:2004 and SB 107-2-D1:2004) require special test equipment, for example special test gauges. Until now no other CBTL have been able to perform the tests that require these special test equipments.

2. In addition to the CB Test Certificate and CB Test Report, what is needed in your opinion in order to increase your confidence in order to avoid asking for sample(s) and improving the recognition timeframe?

As commented above, UL Demko is only requesting samples in exceptional cases. In our opinion the existing rules including use of standardized TRFs and photographs are in general cases covering all our needs for documentation to enable granting our mark..
