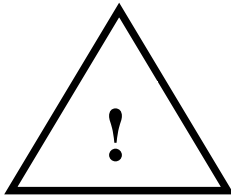

The prompt registration of unsatisfactory situations and a detailed reporting to IECEE Secretariat should be ensured by NCBs.
