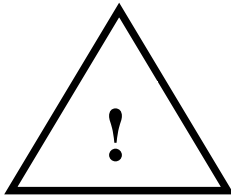

*Greater use of the IECEE FCS system would increase confidence in continued compliance. Additional confidence will be gained if reports are complete including the items identified above. In particular clearer and more complete marking plate information, clear photographs and testing to National deviations clearly stated with documented test results will lead to quicker recognition and higher confidence.*
