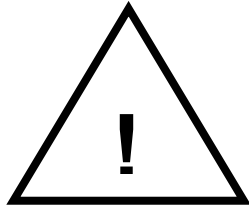

Detailed information related to “EMC Regulatory Requirements” that apply in your country when an Applicant seeks a Certification Mark from the relevant NCBs located in your country:

There are no NCB marks required to meet Canadian Regulations for EMC. Products must comply with the corresponding Industry Canada ICES Standard (such as ICES-003 for IT products). Compliance is a Manufacturer/importer/distributor self-declaration with an Engineering signed Test Report from a Industry Canada accredited Test Lab, which can be either a manufacturer or 3rd party test facility.

Products must also comply with specific bilingual product labeling and documentation, with corresponding notices and declaration to the ICES Standard of compliance in both English and French language.
