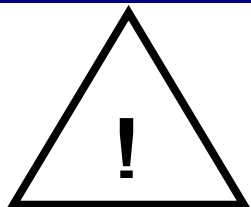

Detailed information related to “EMC Regulatory Requirements” that apply in your country when an Applicant seeks a Certification Mark from the relevant NCBs located in your country: [Greece](#)

1) At the present ELOT conformity mark does not specifically address EMC issues. As part of the documentation inspection, the manufacturer is expected to comply with relevant EU legislation which provide for CE marking.

2) Preliminary discussions have been held with an EMC laboratory in Greece, which has the status of a Notified Body, in order to explore the possibility to include EMC in the scope of CB ELOT.

3) The relevant EU legislation (Directive 89/336/EC as amended by Directives 92/31/EC and 93/68/EC) has been transposed into Greek national law through the Common Ministerial Decision 94649/8682/93 (FEK 688 B/1994-09-13). The Decision enforces in Greece, among others, the requirements for a declaration of conformity, CE marking and technical dossier to be made available to the National Market Surveillance Authorities upon request. The relevant authority is the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
