<p>Question: Reconsideration of the Paris decision item 4 was requested regarding luminaires needing assembly by the user, with particular reference to pendant luminaires with glass shades where the manufacturer wanted to transport them in parts for their protection. It was noted that there is not always a clear distinction between industrial and domestic luminaires.</p> <p>Decision: The Paris decision will stand: “All Countries agreed that luminaires can only be regarded as a complete with all internal wiring mounted. However, if needed for industrial luminaires, the luminaire can be supplied in more than one piece”.
