<p><b>Question:</b> Is it a correct interpretation to delete “if applicable” from the standard in sub clause 3.2.6.?</p> <p><b>Decision:</b> No. Ordinary luminaires do not have to be marked IP20, even though they are required to comply with the requirements of IP20. All other classifications are required to be marked. The term “if applicable” refers to “luminaires other than ordinary”.</p> <p><b>Explanatory notes:</b> See also document 34D/LUMEX(SEC)566.</p>
