Subject: Luminaires needing reconnection by the installer	Key words: - Reconnection - Extra terminal - Different voltages or wattages	Meeting: OSM/LUM No. 19 Item: 13.1.1.A
<p>Question: Is it acceptable that the installer, in order to choose between 230 V or 240 V, shall make a reconnection of the internal conductor on the ballast terminals? This procedure is in contradiction with the requirements given in 0.4.2. In addition are terminals on the modern ballasts in most cases intended for permanent connection only.</p> <p>Decision: Luminaires intended for reconnection between different voltages or wattages, should be provided with a properly marked terminal for the connection of the relevant mains supply, i.e. an extra terminal.</p> <p>Explanatory notes: --</p>
