<p><b>Question:</b></p> <p>What requirements should be applied to switches?</p> <p><b>Rationale:</b></p> <p>See question.</p> <p><b>Decision:</b></p> <p>A switch not previously tested for compliance with IEC61058 (or CEE 24) shall be examined and tested completely in accordance with the requirements of IEC 335-1, including Appendix ZA, which requires tests on 3 samples.</p> <p>A switch previously tested and found to comply with IEC 61058 (or CEE 24 including Amendments 1 up to and including 4) and which covers its application in the appliance shall be accepted without any further testing other than that which occurs as a result of the specified appliance tests.</p> <p><b><u>EXPLANATION:</u></b></p> <p>The same decision (n.38) is present in the OSM/HA decision list</p>
