

Certification Requirements

About our NCB

FORCE Certification A/S is a Notified Body ([NANDO # 0200](#)) for amongst others the Construction Product Regulative (CPR), Low Voltage Directive, EMC Directive and RED Directive and holds accreditation according to ISO/IEC 17025 and ISO/IEC 17065.

Applicant submitting a CB Test Certificate can be:

National manufacturer or his agent

Foreign manufacturer

Foreign manufacturer via representative resident in the country

Commercial agent

CB Scheme Certification Procedures

Documents to be submitted:

- Signed Application Form (stating name and address)
- Valid CB Test Certificate
- Valid CB Test Report (max. 1 year old)
- General contract (available on request)
- Other relevant test results and product data such as manuals, photos, schematics, component list, artwork drawings, etc. may also be required.

Further document

- In case additional testing is required, we require a specimen of the product when a CB Test Certificate is presented, unless a specific agreement exists
- We are prepared to accept an annex to the CB Test Report covering the National Differences.
- Applications for recognition of a CB Test Certificate and Test Report are treated as a priority, provided the need for re-testing is minimal.
- Information on fees is available upon request, after review of the application. First-time applicants are requested to pay in advance a deposit covering the estimated cost of the work. Actual service charges assessed on time/cost basis are invoiced upon completion of the project against the deposit held for each application.

Processing

Applications for the CB-Scheme are dealt with priority and an offer will be send to you in a timely manner.

In case of doubt, samples for further re-testing may be required. Testing costs for such samples are charged to the applicant if deviations have been found.

Certification is valid for those years for which the product is under FORCE Certification A/S surveillance and for the validity period as stated in the certificate, unless the certificate is cancelled because of non-compliance or on the applicant's request.

Appeal in writing against decisions of the NCB shall be directed to the Managing Director of FORCE Certification A/S, Park Allé 345, DK 2605 Brøndby, Denmark.
