Travel Documentation

All meeting attendees and accompanying persons traveling to the USA must have a valid passport. Delegates are urged to consult with their embassy or local travel agency concerning the details of any visa requirements. If you must acquire a visa to enter the United States, please request an invitation letter for the visa process through the IECEE Meeting Registration System as you register for the meeting.

Arrival

Per the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, all non-U.S. citizens and non-U.S. immigrants traveling to the United States by air are required to show proof of being [fully vaccinated](#) against COVID-19. Only [limited exceptions](#) apply. Learn more about this [requirement](#) and [accepted vaccines](#).

If you are not [fully vaccinated](#) and allowed to travel to the United States by air through an exception, you **will be required** to sign an attestation (legal statement) **before you board your flight** to the United States stating you meet the exception. Depending on the type of [exception](#), you may also have to state you have arranged to take certain protective measures.

Getting there by plane

Milwaukee is served by General Mitchell International Airport (MKE), which is around 16 km from downtown Milwaukee and the meeting venue, all of which can be accessed by taxi or ride-sharing services such as Uber and Lyft.

Many flights to and from international destinations will require routing through airline hubs, primarily Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD). Chicago O'Hare International Airport is approximately a 90 minute drive to downtown Milwaukee.

Getting there by bus from Chicago O'Hare

One option for those arriving at Chicago O'Hare International Airport is to take the [Coach USA bus](#) at Door 5E outside the international terminal (Terminal E), or Door #4 if arriving from terminals 1, 2 or 3. Take the bus to Milwaukee Intermodal Station/Amtrak, which is 3 blocks from the meeting venue. Tickets are \$34.10 USD one way and \$61.60 USD roundtrip.

Additional Information

Local Time: Local time in Milwaukee is Central Daylight Time (US)

Credit cards: Visa, Mastercard/Eurocard, American Express, Diners Club and Discover cards are accepted at all hotels, restaurants, and shops.

Currency: Currency can be exchanged most conveniently within airport terminals. U.S. currency can also be obtained at any automated teller machine (ATM). The US dollar (USD) is the only currency accepted for cash payments. [Go here](#) for up-to-date currency exchange rates

Electricity supply: 120 V at 60 Hz. The following figures illustrate the standard plug and receptacle configurations used in the United States.



Taxes and Tipping: The combined sales tax in the city of Milwaukee is 5.5% for services, merchandise and on restaurant bills. At restaurants, a tip of 15-20% of the total bill excluding tax is customary for satisfactory service.

Weather: In summer, daytime conditions in the Milwaukee area are pleasant overall with an average high temperature of 23 °C. Evening temperatures can fall to around 20 °C.

Internet: There will be Wi-Fi Internet access for all delegates inside the venue area. Internet access may also be available in coffee shops, and at hotels. Hotels may charge access fees for internet access.

Emergencies and Insurance: The emergency number for paramedic, police, and fire services is 9-1-1. Attendees are responsible for obtaining travel, medical, personal, accident, and luggage insurance. The USNC/IECEE accepts no liability for any loss or injury incurred.

Gala Dinner: For the attending members, there will be a Gala dinner the evening of June 28th. Details to be provided once they are available. It is assumed that all participants and their accompanying persons will be attending the Gala dinner.

Members planning to attend should make hotel arrangements as early as possible as there is a world-famous music festival (<https://www.summerfest.com/>) happening the weekend before and the weekend after the meeting.
